**NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**NOVICE SENIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN JUNIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN SENIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**MASTER CLASS:** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open Class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

**BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES:** Engraved Silver Plate Trophy In Memory of Dr. J.P. McCain by the Collie Club of Western Pennsylvania. The trophy must be won three times for permanent possession, not necessarily with the same dog. The name of the winning dog will be engraved at the Club's expense. The trophy will remain in the possession of the Collie Club of Western Pennsylvania until all legs are won. A wooden plaque will be given to the winner with the year engraved on it to show the win.

This is a self-cleaning show. Owners or agents are required to clean up after their own dogs in all buildings and outside on grounds. Crates only in buildings. NO EX-PENS ALLOWD INSIDE. NO UNDERAGE PUPPIES OR UN-ENTERED DOGS. NO ALCOHOL ALLOWED ON THE PREMISES.

CHALKING WILL BE DONE IN SIDE. CHALKING IN THE BUILDING. ALL SHAVINGS MUST BE CLEANED UP AFTER EX-PENS IS REMOVED.

- All dogs must be removed from the building each night.
- Crates must be stacked if space is limited and will be determined as such by the Show Committee.
- The use of foul or abusive language may result in a hearing of the Bench Committee
- NO SMOKING WILL BE ALLOWED IN ANY OF THE BUILDINGS.
- Spectators/exhibitors are allowed to videotape dogs in the ring as long as it does not interfere with judging, the comfort of other exhibitors and/or obstruct the free flow of foot traffic. Flash photography of dogs while they are competing inside the show ring is not permitted.
- All persons attending this show hereby waive any claim for damages against the Collie Club of Western Pennsylvania/Panhandle Collie Club of West Virginia or its members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
- Please keep your area clean. Garbage bags will be available for your dog hair and garbage.

No refunds for duplicate entries. Every effort to find duplicate entries will be made. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellations after the published closing date and time.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called. Dogs arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Class cash prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging is over. The Show Secretary, Collie Club of Western Pennsylvania and The Panhandle Collie Club of West Virginia disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging is over. All trophies will be awarded in the ring. No trophies will be mailed.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, Disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of The Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as but not limited to storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat must be considered for the health and safety of the exhibitors, dogs and spectators. The well being of the Dogs, Exhibitors and Spectators is of paramount importance and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completions, no refund of entry fees will be made.
